Application Process

To apply for a MSL Music Study Grant, a student must be: (1) a member of the Montgomery Youth Orchestra (MYO); (2) between the ages of 14 and 18 years on the application deadline date; and (3) in “good standing” after a period of at least three months of membership.

Good standing is determined by such factors as attending rehearsals regularly, displaying a courteous attitude and cooperative spirit, and handling MYO materials responsibly.

Eligibility: In all cases, the decision of the MSL is final.

During a Music Study Grant year, an MYO member who also plays with the MSO may seek a grant through either group but is expected to continue as a member in good standing with the MYO.

Application Forms

Application forms are available at MYO rehearsals and on the MSO website (www.montgomerysymphony.org). Forms must be completed and returned to the MSL VP for Youth by the stated period. A separate form must be submitted for each grant period.

Applicants must submit three forms: one providing personal information and one, written by the student, providing a paragraph stating the student’s music goals and how the grant will help in fulfilling those goals. In addition, on or before the end of the grant period, recipients must submit a third form describing how the money was used. This form is important and required. Failure to submit this last form will make the student ineligible for future MSL Music Study Grants.
